
HOSPITAL UNIFIED RESPONSE TRAINING PROGRAM

The Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP) provides a set of guiding principles for exercise programs, as well as a common approach to exercise program management, design and development, conduct, evaluation, and improvement planning. The Blue Cell, LLC will design, facilitate and guide in the execution of your exercise. An After-Action Report/Improvement Plans (AAR/IP)draft for your exercise will be prepared documenting strengths, areas for improvement, core capability performance, and corrective actions. We use standard exercise doctrines and employ FEMA certified master exercise practitioners.

HSEEP exercise and evaluation doctrine is flexible, scalable, adaptable, and is for use by stakeholders across the whole community and Hospital and Health Care specific exercise experience. HSEEP doctrine is applicable for exercises across all mission areas—prevention, protection,



mitigation, response, and recovery. Using HSEEP supports the National Preparedness System by providing a consistent approach to exercises and measuring progress toward building, sustaining, and delivering core capabilities. Understanding and using core capabilities is a key to The Blue Cell's track record of success in the management, evaluation and improvement planning of exercises. HSEEP doctrine is based on national best practices and is supported by training, technology systems, tools, and technical assistance. To further enhance this specific capability integrated planning tools are available to allow both electronic collaboration with customers throughout the design process and archiving of previous exercise work.
